ONE WEEK REMAINS TO START OF THIRTY-NINTH SPACE CONGRESS

Exhibit Hall Sold Out, Congress Registration Still Available

PORT CANAVERAL, Fla., April 23, 2002 – One week remains to the start of the 39th Space Congress Tuesday, April 30. The Congress will begin with a keynote address by Dr. Vance D. Coffman, Chairman of the Board and Chief Executive Officer of Lockheed Martin Corporation, at 8:00 a.m. April 30 at the Radisson Resort, Cape Canaveral.

Dr. Coffman heads up a roster of speakers including Art Stephenson, Director of NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center, Lt. Gen. Brian Arnold, Commander of Space and Missiles Systems Center, and Mike McCulley, Chief Operating Officer of United Space Alliance.

Over 40 space-related companies will showcase the latest in technology in the Space Congress exhibit hall adjacent to the Radisson Resort Convention Center. Student science fair entries will also be on display throughout the Congress.

Registration can be made by mail or on-line. A complete registration package is \$180, which includes the conference fee, the opening banquet, exhibitors' reception and two luncheons.

Sponsored by the Canaveral Council of Technical Societies (CCTS), Space Congress is organized in cooperation with NASA, the Department of Defense, industry and academia. Since CCTS's first symposium in 1962, the Congress has provided for a gathering of the world's aerospace community to discuss the status and future of space activities around the world.
